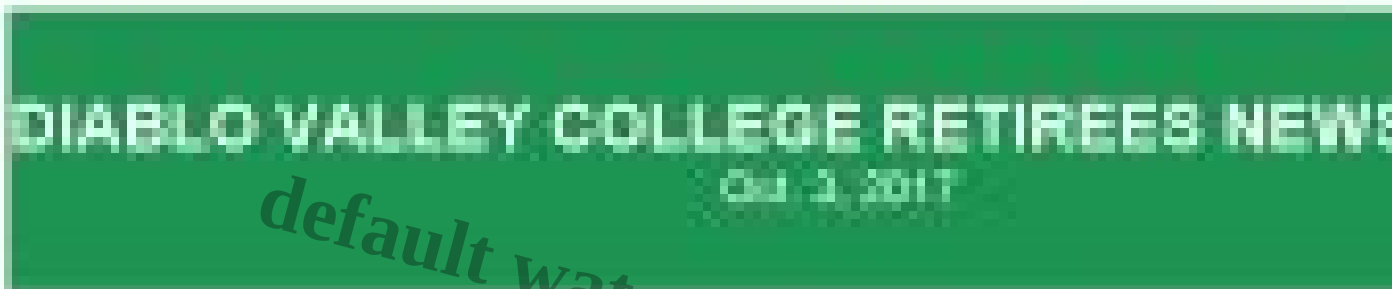

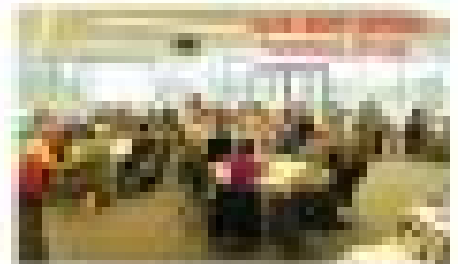

Do you have questions about your health care benefits?

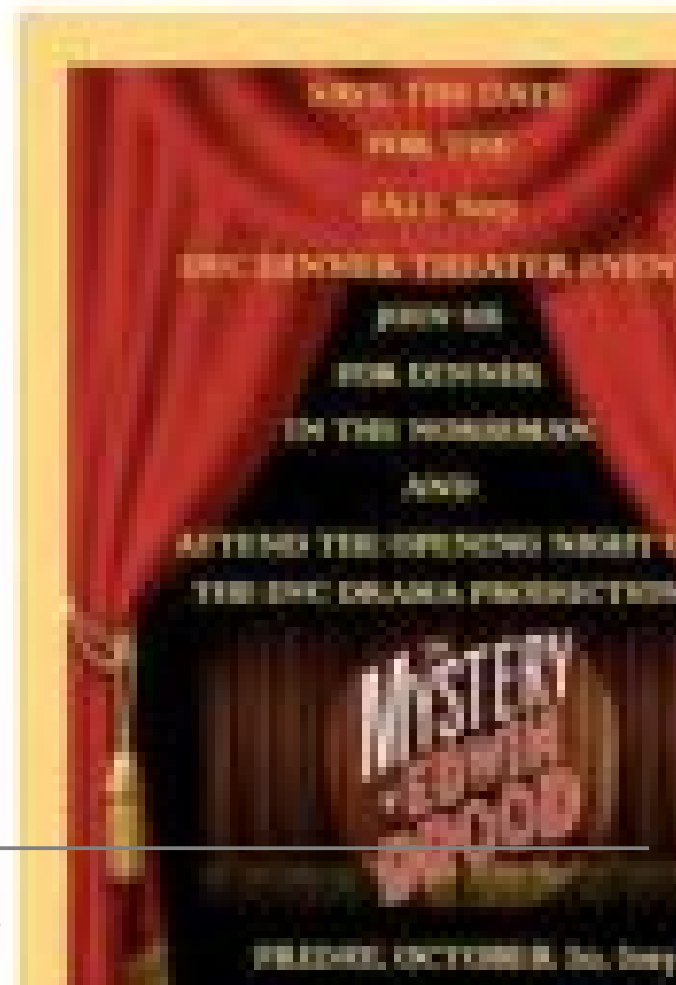
Attendees at our luncheon last fall gave high marks to the Human Resources Department's presentation about health care benefits.

Financial Report

The primary purpose for the raising is to award scholarships to DVC students. The annual award scholarship fund grows out a total of \$1,000 in 2017. The award and fund scholarship are used for awarding efforts every day. Consequently, the funds raised in 2017 fund the scholarships in 2018. The following information is for the period Aug. 1, 2017:

- We have \$15,100 in cash balance accounts at Trinity Credit Union Foundation.
- Our fund raising activities in donations, memberships, and \$12,000 available for scholarship.
- Approximately 50 percent of donations for scholarships, \$12,000 in donations in 2017.
- In 2017 we partnered with the DVCBL Foundation to get benefit of 50 percent of our donations. This is 50 percent of our donations directly to the DVCBL Foundation.
- We had \$11,100 in expenses including \$10,000 for scholarship fund and \$1,100 in office.

During the morning, the Board decided to increase the award scholarship and the total number of awards. The DVCBL will award 100
